

SHARE – I a newly established platform for Social Sciences and Humanities in Ionising Radiation Research.

It aims to contribute to RP research and practice, as well as policy related to RP, including research policy

SHARE currently has 24 members which include research institutes, universities, consultancies, and individuals, with a large range of competences in SSH fields and focusing on ionizing radiation

Why do we need SHARE?

So far, SSH has not been fully integrated in research projects or proposals. That is despite the increasing recognition of the need for the SSH research and its intergration e.g. in the context of responsible research and innovation.

And to aid that integration, SHARE now provides a critical mass of researchers with a lot of energy to further SSH at different levels and on different topics

SHARE could contribute with:

- inspiring or improving guidance of SSH in existing RP plans
- contributing to research, education and training programmes, etc.
- provide a venue for recruiting evaluators of proposals
- provide a list of competent researchers in different fields to contribute to European proposals and our SRA outlines some areas of expertise

You can see some of our areas of expertise in the SRA which has been published and is open access.
